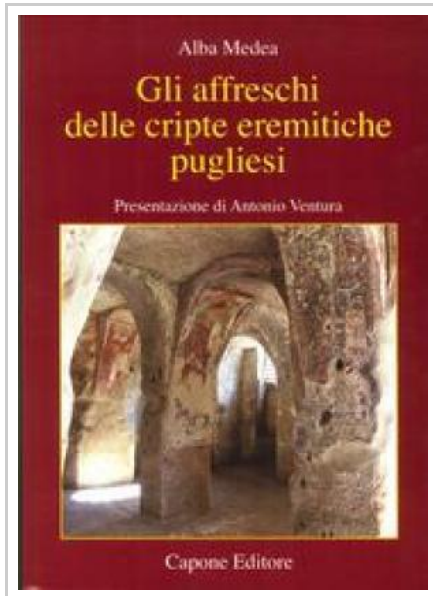




Gli Affreschi delle Cripte Eremitiche Pugliesi.
